The men will race two events at each track we will take your best score at each track plus the Championship final on August 25th, and those scores will determine the Champion. For the ladies we will run one event per track plus the Championship Final to determine the champion. No points, no trophies, no Pros invited. We will have some nice awards for the top 3 in each class, so get ready for some intense bar to bar racing in this one!
